Highlights:

- Total system ridership for June was 3,592,355; a decrease of 12.11% or 494,800 rides compared to June 2009. There was the same number of weekdays, Saturdays and Sundays as last year. In comparison to last year, average weekday ridership dropped 12.1%, which translates to a loss of 20,089 trips per day. Compared to last year, year-to-date system ridership decreased 11.4% or approximately 2,800,000 rides. Bus ridership in June decreased 13.4% or approximately 457,000 rides.

- The HealthLine once again showed an increase in ridership with 327,200 rides taken in June, a 5.72% increase over last June. Compared to last June, about 17,700 more rides were taken.

- Total Rapid Transit ridership decreased by 5.93% in June. Light Rail decreased 3.9% for the month and Heavy Rail decreased 4.4% year to date.

- Trolley ridership in June was 81,210; an increase of 1.1%, or 872 more rides than last June. Average daily trolley ridership was 3,691 rides.

Ridership Initiatives and Special Promotions:

- During June, several new clients signed up for the Commuter Advantage program including: Kmart Stores, Target Corporation, Nationwide Mutual Insurance Co., Community First Church, and Westside Catholic Center.

- RTA employees surveyed customers on the Red Line at various stations June 8 and June 9. This information will be used to better service the customers and improve the Red Line.

- A minor service change was effective on June 13. Twenty-three timetables changed.

- June 17 was National Dump the Pump Day. Seven organizations around greater Cleveland participated in the RTA event, which by purchasing blocks of all day passes; their employees were able to try transit for the day. Fifty percent of these proceeds were donated to the National Wildlife Fund to help clean up the animals affected by the Gulf oil spill.

- In June, several events occurred around the city, including concerts at the House of Blues, Quicken Loans Arena and CSU Wolstein Center, Earth, Wind & Fire at Tower City Amphitheater, as well as numerous Cleveland Gladiators and Cleveland Indians home games. To accommodate the large crowds of spectators, RTA offered additional rail service. In addition, RTA has more than 7,000 free parking spaces at rail stations and park-and-ride lots to ensure safe, speedy, and affordable travel to and from events.

- During the month of June, RTA participated in several community events throughout the Greater Cleveland area including speaking engagements and informational sessions at CMHA Senior Jamboree, Parma Seniors Community Day, Safety Day at Job Corp, Safety Day at the Zoo, Tri-C Student communications tour, Cleveland Foundation Center intern tour, Central Family to Family Collaborative, TIAC and Citizen's Advisory Board Committee Meetings. By design, these events increase RTA's presence within the Greater Cleveland community and enhance public transit awareness.
